Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depends on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:  • Social Security Number and driver's license number  • Account balances and income  • Addresses and contact information  When you are no longer our client, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
How?	All financial companies need to share client's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their client's personal information; the reasons WW chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does WW protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does WW collect my personal information?	<ul> <li>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</li> <li>Open or close an account</li> <li>Authorize a trade or authorize a direct fee-deduction</li> <li>Authorize to raise cash</li> <li>Have a financial plan prepared</li> <li>We may also collect your personal information from other companies.</li> </ul>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<ul> <li>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</li> <li>Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>Affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> <li>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</li> </ul>
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.  Winthrop Wealth has no affiliates.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.  These include broker/dealers, mutual fund companies, insurance companies and other financial institutions.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.  Winthrop Wealth does not do joint marketing.
